*There will be a meetup for the elementary, junior high school and senior high school children on **September 7th (Sun) from 9:00 AM.**

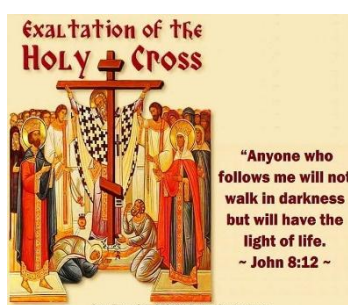
* Church Council Meeting is on September 13th (Sat) from 10:00 AM.
