


PRAYERS FOR FEBRUARY 2026

God of goodness and love, hear our prayers for the sick members of our family, friends and loved ones, and all who are in need.


Amid mental and physical pain, may they find consolation in your healing presence.

Amen.






PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

Celebrated 40 days after Christmas, this feast marks the day when Mary and Joseph presented Jesus in the Temple, according to the Jewish Law.

Simeon, whom the Holy Spirit had revealed would not die until he had seen the Messiah, and the prophetess Anna, recognizing Jesus as the 'light' of the world, joyfully proclaimed His presence.

This feast is often called Candlemas, because the Gospel describes Jesus as the 'light to the nations' according to the prophecy of Simeon.
